AN ACT in relation to elderly persons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Respite Program Act is amended by 5 changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (320 ILCS 10/5) (from Ch. 23, par. 6205)

7 Sec. 5. Eligibility. The Department may establish eligibility standards for respite services taking into 8 consideration the unique economic and social needs of the 9 population for whom they are to be provided. The population 10 11 identified for the purposes of this Act includes persons suffering from Alzheimer's disease and who are 55 years of 12 age or older, or persons age 60 and older with an identified 13 14 service need. Priority <u>must</u> shall be given in all cases to frail, abused or functionally disabled or cognitively 15 16 impaired adults.
