- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 12.1 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 5/12.1) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 1012.1)
- 7 Sec. 12.1. <u>Underground injection of hazardous waste;</u>
- 8 <u>prohibition</u>.
- 9 (a) Commencing June 30, 1984 and until January 1, 1986,
- 10 no person shall cause, threaten or allow the underground
- 11 injection of hazardous waste unless:
- 12 (1) the underground injection is into an existing
- well or a replacement well; and
- 14 (2) the underground injection will not violate this
- 15 Act or any regulation or standard adopted by the Board
- 16 under this Act.
- 17 (b) For purposes of this Section, an existing well is a
- 18 well that is in existence on the effective date of this
- 19 amendatory Act of 1984.
- 20 (c) For purposes of this Section, a replacement well is
- 21 a well that:
- 22 (1) replaces an existing inoperative or stand-by
- well; and
- 24 (2) is located within the same site as the
- 25 inoperative existing well.
