AN ACT concerning correctional facilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Private Correctional Facility Moratorium
Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows:

6 (730 ILCS 140/3) (from Ch. 38, par. 1583)

Certain contracts prohibited. 7 Sec. 3. After the 8 effective date of this Act, the State shall not contract with a private contractor or private vendor for the provision of 9 services relating to the operation of a correctional facility 10 or the incarceration of persons in the custody of the 11 12 Department of Corrections;-however,-this-Act-does--not--apply 13 to--(1)--State--work--release-centers-or-juvenile-residential 14 facilities-that-provide-separate-care--or--special--treatment 15 operated--in--whole--or--part--by--private-contractors-or-(2) 16 contracts-for-ancillary-services,-including-medical-services, 17 educational-services,-repair-and--maintenance--contracts,--or 18 other---services--not--directly--related--to--the--ownership, 19 management--or--operation---of---security---services---in---a 20 correctional-facility.
