AN ACT in relation to the regulation of professions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Public Accounting Act is amended
by changing Section 1 as follows:

Sec. 1. Any person, 18 eighteen years of age or older, 9 who has received from the University of Illinois, hereinafter 10 called the University, a certificate of his qualifications as 11 12 hereinafter provided, shall be styled and known as a 13 "Certified Public Accountant," and no other person shall assume such title or use the abbreviation "C. P.A." or any 14 15 words or letters to indicate that the person using the same is a certified public accountant. 16

Any person, <u>18</u> eighteen years of age or older, 20 who has received from the Board a certificate of his 21 qualifications as hereinafter provided, shall be styled and 22 known as a "Certified Public Accountant," and no other person 23 shall assume such title or use the abbreviation "C.P.A." or 24 any words or letters to indicate that the person using the 25 same is a certified public accountant.

Section 95. No acceleration or delay. Where this Act makes changes in a statute that is represented in this Act by text that is not yet or no longer in effect (for example, a Section represented by multiple versions), the use of that text does not accelerate or delay the taking effect of (i)

- the changes made by this Act or (ii) provisions derived from
