- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 5.25 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 505/5.25 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5.25. Child on ventilator; discharge from hospital.</u>
- 8 If (i) a child is medically ready to be discharged from a
- 9 <u>hospital and is dependent upon a ventilator to support</u>
- 10 <u>breathing</u> and (ii) the Department is responsible for placing
- 11 the child upon discharge from the hospital but cannot place
- 12 the child immediately upon discharge, with the result that
- the child remains in the hospital pending placement, then
- 14 until the child is discharged in accordance with a placement
- by the Department, the Department must continue to reimburse
- 16 the hospital for care provided to the child at the same rate
- 17 <u>at which the Department reimburses the hospital for inpatient</u>
- 18 <u>services.</u>
- 19 Section 10. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 20 adding Section 5-23 as follows:
- 21 (305 ILCS 5/5-23 new)
- 22 <u>Sec. 5-23. Child on ventilator; discharge from hospital.</u>
- 23 <u>If (i) a hospitalized child is dependent upon a ventilator to</u>
- 24 support breathing and that child is medically ready for
- 25 <u>discharge from a hospital but does not have a home</u>
- 26 <u>environment ready to support his or her medical needs and</u>
- 27 (ii) that child is a ward of the Department of Children and
- 28 Family Services or is a recipient of medical assistance under
- 29 this Article V, then the Department of Children and Family

- 1 Services or the Department of Public Aid must continue to
- 2 <u>reimburse</u> the hospital for the care provided to the child at
- 3 <u>the same rate at which the respective department reimburses</u>
- 4 <u>the hospital for inpatient services.</u>
