- for 38 years, which was reported to be the longest volunteer

- 16 Menard Correctional Center to lead worship service and
- minister to her "sons" by scripture, song, testimony, prayer,
- 18 preaching, pen pal correspondence, and by the love of Jesus
- 19 each man saw in her face; the individuals she ministered to
- 20 returned to society changed, many of them finding jobs,
- 21 providing for their family, and becoming preachers and
- 22 Christian workers; and
- 23 WHEREAS, In 1993, Illinois Governor Jim Edgar cited
- 24 Mother Ada Turner for her 30 years of volunteer service; she
- 25 was recognized for her prison ministry by Illinois Department
- of Corrections Directors, Wardens, and Chaplains, as well as
- 27 Church of God in Christ Bishops and the Church's National
- 28 Womens Auxiliary; in addition, her prison ministry was
- 29 featured in a television documentary in St. Louis; therefore,
