1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Consideration is being given to introducing a
- 3 new overlay area code in the 618 region of the State; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Federal Communications Commission (FCC)
- 5 currently requires 11-digit dialing when an overlay area code
- 6 is implemented; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The FCC's 11-digit dialing mandate is a needles
- 8 inconvenience for residential and business consumers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Residents in the 618 region would be able to
- 10 continue dialing 7 digits for all local calls if the FCC were
- 11 to change its policy on mandatory 11-digit dialing in an
- 12 overlay situation; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The FCC's mandatory 11-digit dialing policy
- 14 could soon affect all the residents of Illinois, as the phone
- industry claims that every area code in the State will be out
- of phone numbers by 2007; and
- WHEREAS, On December 29, 2001, the FCC reversed its
- 18 long-standing opposition to wireless-only overlays, signaling
- 19 that the agency is potentially reconsidering its area code
- 20 policies; therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 22 NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 23 we urge the Federal Communications Commission to grant a
- 24 permanent waiver of the 11-digit dialing mandate for the 618
- 25 region and to change its policy on overlay area codes; and be
- 26 it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 28 presented to the Chairman of the FCC, the Chairman of the
- 29 Illinois Commerce Commission, and each member of the Illinois
- 30 congressional delegation.
