1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The General Assembly sought to enhance care for

- 3 seniors and disabled persons in nursing homes by enacting the
- 4 Tobacco Products Tax Act of 1995, imposing a tax on
- 5 distributors of various tobacco products other than
- 6 cigarettes, such as cigars and chewing tobacco; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The constitutionality of the Tobacco Products
- 8 Act of 1995 has been litigated since the enactment of that
- 9 1995 Act by Arangold Corporation, an Illinois corporation
- 10 doing business as a wholesale tobacco distributor subject to
- 11 the tax; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The constitutionality of the tax has been upheld
- 13 by every court, most recently by the First District Appellate
- 14 Court on April 12, 2002 in the case of Arangold Corporation
- v. Department of Revenue et al; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Arangold Corporation has sought leave to
- 17 appeal before the Illinois Supreme Court and that petition is
- 18 now pending; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois is experiencing a severe
- 20 budget shortfall due to a national economic downturn and
- 21 factors related to the tragic events of September 11, 2001,
- 22 which may result in 8.8% reductions in payments to nursing
- 23 homes in the fiscal year 2003 budget, totaling \$171 million;
- 24 and
- 25 WHEREAS, An escrow fund was established for the
- 26 collection of the tobacco products tax with respect to the
- 27 Tobacco Products Tax Act litigation, and that escrow fund now
- has more than \$70 million on deposit, which, if the funds are
- 29 now released and matched with federal Medicaid funds, would
- 30 result in an additional \$140 million for payments to nursing
- 31 homes in fiscal year 2003; therefore, be it

- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 1 OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 2 3 we urge Attorney General Jim Ryan to file an emergency motion 4 or petition before the Illinois Supreme Court to (a) expedite 5 consideration of the pending petition for leave to appeal, or (b) to seek the immediate release of the moneys held in 6 7 escrow so that adequate funding for nursing home care for seniors and the disabled can be accomplished in the fiscal 8 9 year 2003 budget, or both; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be 11 presented to Attorney General Jim Ryan.
