20 WHEREAS, In the Senate, Senator Noland serves as 21 Vice-Chairman of the Agriculture and Conservation Committee 22 and is a member of the Licensed Activities and State 23 Government Operations Committees; he previously served as 24 chairman of the House Agriculture Committee; and

WHEREAS, Senator Noland is on the Boards of Directors of 25 26 the Mid-Illinois Chapter of the American Red Cross and Lincoln Trails Council of Boy Scouts of America, and he is a 27 member of First Christian Church of Decatur; he has been 28 honored by numerous organizations for outstanding public 29 service, including the Chamber of Commerce Civic Leadership 30 31 Award, and the Council for Food and Agriculture Research Award; and 32

1 WHEREAS, Senator Noland graduated with high honors from 2 the University of Illinois with a Bachelor of Science in 3 Agriculture; he and his wife, Tina Noland, a Millikin 4 University graduate, are the parents of two sons, Grant and 5 Blake; and

WHEREAS, Senator Noland has received numerous awards and б 7 recognitions, including the "Friend of Agriculture" award in the "Friend of the Family" award in 1997, the 8 1996, "Legislator of the Year" award from ABATE in 1998, the 9 Jaycees "Outstanding Young Farmer" award, the DuPont "Young 10 Leader" award, and the American 11 Soybean Association 12 "Outstanding Young Leader for Illinois" award; he is a graduate of the Farm Bureau A LOT program and a fellow in the 13 14 John J. McCloy European Agriculture fellowship; and

WHEREAS, Senator Noland is dedicated to his community and provides his services as a youth baseball and basketball coach; therefore, be it
