- 4 Section 5. The Street Light District Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 5 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 5. <u>Trustees; powers and duties.</u> The trustees shall
- 8 exercise all of the powers and control all the affairs and
- 9 property of such district. The board of trustees, immediately
- 10 after their appointment and at their first meeting in May of
- 11 each year thereafter, shall elect one of their number as
- 12 president and one of their number as secretary. The board
- shall prescribe the duties and fix the compensation of all of
- 14 the officers and employees of the street lighting district.÷
- 15 Provided--that A member of the board of trustees, however,
- shall in no case receive a sum to exceed \$300.00 per annum,
- 17 <u>except that trustees whose terms begin on or after the first</u>
