- 1 AN ACT regarding the discharge of ballast water.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5.543 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.543 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5.543. The Aquatic Nuisance Species Prevention</u>
- 8 <u>Fund.</u>
- 9 Section 10. The Environmental Protection Act is amended
- 10 by adding Section 12.5 as follows:
- 11 (415 ILCS 5/12.5 new)
- 12 <u>Sec. 12.5. Ballast water and sediment; permit;</u>
- inspection program.
- 14 (a) For the purposes of this Section:
- 15 <u>"Ballast water" means water and associated solids taken</u>
- on board a vessel to control or maintain trim, draft,
- 17 <u>stability</u>, or <u>stresses</u> on the <u>vessel</u>, <u>without regard to the</u>
- 18 manner in which the water and associated solids are carried.
- 19 <u>"Sediment" means any matter settled out of ballast water</u>
- within a vessel.
- 21 <u>"Sterilized" means the treatment of ballast water or</u>
- 22 <u>sediment, or both, to destroy or remove all living biological</u>
- 23 <u>organisms through filtration</u>, thermal methods, ultraviolet
- 24 light, biocides, or other techniques approved by the Agency.
- (b) Beginning on January 1, 2002, a person shall not
- 26 operate on the waters of the State a vessel that contains
- 27 <u>ballast water that was acquired outside the waters of the</u>
- 28 State, unless the ballast water and any sediment therefrom

- 1 <u>have been sterilized as required by Agency rule.</u>
- 2 (c) Beginning on January 1, 2002, a person shall not
- 3 cause ballast water or sediment to be discharged, directly or
- 4 indirectly, into the waters of the State, unless the
- 5 <u>discharge is authorized by a permit issued by the Agency.</u>
- 6 (d) The Agency shall establish a Ballast Water and
- 7 <u>Sediment Inspection Program that assures that aquatic</u>
- 8 <u>nuisance species do not enter the waters of the State through</u>
- 9 the direct or indirect discharge of ballast water or
- 10 sediment.
- 11 (e) The Agency shall adopt such procedures and impose
- 12 <u>such conditions as are necessary to implement the provisions</u>
- of this Section, including filing requirements and procedures
- 14 that are appropriate and necessary for the issuance of
- 15 permits under this Section.
- 16 (f) The Agency shall assess application and inspection
- fees in amounts necessary to implement the provisions of this
- 18 <u>Section</u>. All fees received by the Agency under this <u>Section</u>
- 19 <u>shall</u> <u>be</u> <u>deposited</u> <u>into</u> <u>the</u> <u>Aquatic</u> <u>Nuisance</u> <u>Species</u>
- 20 Prevention Fund, an interest-bearing special fund created in
- 21 the State treasury. Subject to appropriation, moneys in the
- 22 <u>Fund shall be used by the Agency to implement the provisions</u>
- of this Section.
