With the concurrence of 16 Superintendent of Education, he may employ such assistance as is necessary to conduct the inservice training 17 With the approval of the regional superintendent, 18 workshop. 19 2 or more adjoining districts may jointly hold an inservice training workshop. In addition, with the approval of the 20 21 regional superintendent, one district may conduct its own inservice training workshop with subject matter consultants 22 23 requested from the county, State or any State institution of higher learning. 24 25 Such teachers institutes as referred to in this Section 26 may be held on consecutive or separate days at the option of 27 the regional superintendent having jurisdiction thereof. However, (i) in odd-numbered years, a teachers institute 28 shall be held on the day set aside for the conduct of the 29 30 consolidated election and on the day set aside for the 31 conduct of the consolidated primary election and (ii) in even 32 numbered years, a teachers institute shall be held on the day set aside for the conduct of the general election.
