AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 188

4 "Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing
5 Section 11-4.1 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/11-4.1) (from Ch. 46, par. 11-4.1)

Sec. 11-4.1. (a) In appointing polling places under this
Article, the county board or board of election commissioners
shall, insofar as they are convenient and available, use
schools and other public buildings as polling places.

(b) Upon request of the county board or board of 11 election commissioners, the proper agency of government 12 (including school districts and units of local government) 13 shall make a public building under its control available for 14 use as a polling place on an election day and for a 15 reasonably necessary time before and after election day, 16 without charge, unless such use is impossible. If the county 17 board or board of election commissioners chooses a school to 18 be a polling place, then the school district must make the 19 school available for use as a polling place; however, a 20 21 teachers institute may be held on election day.

22 (c) A government agency which makes a public building

under its control available for use as a polling place shall ensure the portion of the building to be used as the polling place is accessible to handicapped and elderly voters. (Source: P.A. 84-1467.)
