- 7 Sec. 6-3. Intoxicated or drugged condition.
- 8 A person who is in an intoxicated or drugged condition is
- 9 criminally responsible for conduct unless such condition

- 11 (a)--Is--so-extreme-as-to-suspend-the-power-of-reason-and
- 12 render-him-incapable-of-forming-a-specific-intent-which-is-an
- 13 element-of-the-offense;-or
- 14 (b) is involuntarily produced and deprives him of
- 15 substantial capacity either to appreciate the criminality of
- 16 his conduct or to conform his conduct to the requirements of
- 17 law.
