11	stickers to be furnished by the Secretary of State.
12	(a) The Secretary of State upon registering a vehicle
13	subject to annual registration for the first time shall
14	issue or shall cause to be issued to the owner one
15	registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer, semitrailer,
16	motorized pedalcycle or truck-tractor, 2 registration plates
17	for other motor vehicles and, where applicable, current
18	registration stickers for motor vehicles of the first

The Secretary shall forward to the Department of Public Aid registration information for the purpose of 26 verification of claims filed with the Department by owners of 27 medical carriers or rescue vehicles for payment for services 28 29 to public assistance recipients.

(a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made 13 14 in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special registration plates designated as Hospice license plates. 15 The special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed 16 17 only to passenger vehicles of the first division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 18 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire 19 20 according to the multi-year procedure established by Section 21 <u>3-414.1 of this Code.</u>

(b) The color of the plates is wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. The design of the plates shall include the word "Hospice" above drawings of two lilies and a butterfly. The Secretary may allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized under Section 3-405.1 of the Code. The Secretary shall prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412 of this Code.

29 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged 30 a \$25 fee for original issuance in addition to the 31 appropriate registration fee. Of this fee, \$10 shall be 32 deposited into the Hospice Fund and \$15 shall be deposited 33 into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be
