1 AN ACT concerning animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Humane Care for Animals Act is amended by 5 changing Sections 2.07 and 4.01 as follows:

Sec. 2.07. <u>Person.</u> "Person" means any individual, <u>minor, firm, corporation, partnership, other business unit,</u> society, association, or other legal entity, any public or private institution, the State of Illinois, or any municipal corporation or political subdivision of the State.

14 Sec. 4.01. <u>Prohibitions.</u>

15 (a) No person may own, capture, breed, train, or lease 16 any animal which he or she knows or should know is intended 17 for use in any show, exhibition, program, or other activity 18 featuring or otherwise involving a fight between such animal 19 and any other animal or human, or the intentional killing of 20 any animal for the purpose of sport, wagering, or 21 entertainment.

22 (b) No person shall promote, conduct, carry on, 23 advertise, collect money for or in any other manner assist 24 or aid in the presentation for purposes of sport, wagering, 25 or entertainment, any show, exhibition, program, or other 26 activity involving a fight between 2 or more animals or any 27 animal and human, or the intentional killing of any animal.

(c) No person shall sell or offer for sale, ship,
transport, or otherwise move, or deliver or receive any
animal which he or she knows or should know has been

captured, bred, or trained, or will be used, to fight another
 animal or human or be intentionally killed, for the purpose
 of sport, wagering, or entertainment.

(d) No person shall manufacture for sale, shipment,
transportation or delivery any device or equipment which that
person knows or should know is intended for use in any show,
exhibition, program, or other activity featuring or otherwise
involving a fight between 2 or more animals, or any human and
animal, or the intentional killing of any animal for purposes
of sport, wagering or entertainment.

11 (e) No person shall own, possess, sell or offer for 12 sale, ship, transport, or otherwise move any equipment or device which such person knows or should know is intended for 13 use in connection with any show, exhibition, program, or 14 15 activity featuring or otherwise involving a fight between 2 16 or more animals, or any animal and human, or the intentional killing of any animal for purposes of sport, wagering or 17 entertainment. 18

(f) No person shall make available any site, structure, or facility, whether enclosed or not, which he or she knows or should know is intended to be used for the purpose of conducting any show, exhibition, program, or other activity involving a fight between 2 or more animals, or any animal and human, or the intentional killing of any animal.

(g) No person shall attend or otherwise patronize any show, exhibition, program, or other activity featuring or otherwise involving a fight between 2 or more animals, or any animal and human, or the intentional killing of any animal for the purposes of sport, wagering or entertainment.

30 (h) No person shall tie or attach or fasten any live 31 animal to any machine or device propelled by any power for 32 the purpose of causing such animal to be pursued by a dog or 33 dogs. This subsection (h) shall apply only when such dog is 34 intended to be used in a dog fight.

1 (i) Any animals or equipment involved in a violation of 2 this Section shall be immediately seized and impounded under Section 12 by the Department when located at any show, 3 4 exhibition, program, or other activity featuring or otherwise involving an animal fight. The equipment shall be destroyed, 5 6 and the animals humanely euthanized as approved by the Department after attempts to find the animals' owners have 7 8 been exhausted.

9 (j) Any vehicle or conveyance other than a common 10 carrier that is used in violation of this Section shall be 11 seized, held, and offered for sale at public auction by the 12 sheriff's department of the proper jurisdiction, and the 13 proceeds from the sale shall be remitted to the general fund 14 of the the county where the violation took place.

15 (k) Any veterinarian in this State who is presented with 16 an animal for treatment of injuries or wounds resulting from 17 fighting where there is a reasonable possibility that the animal was engaged in or utilized for a fighting event shall 18 19 file a report with the Department and cooperate by furnishing the owners' names, dates, and descriptions of the animal or 20 21 animals involved. 22 (1) No person shall conspire or solicit a minor to

23 violate this Section. A violation of this subsection is a
24 <u>Class A misdemeanor.</u>
