- 1 AN ACT in relation to counties.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 3-6040 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/3-6040 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3-6040. Company for the apprehension of criminals</u>
- 8 and the recovery of stolen property. There is within the
- 9 Office of the Will County Sheriff a company of at least 20
- 10 citizens organized for the purpose of detecting and
- 11 apprehending criminals against the laws of the State of
- 12 <u>Illinois</u>. The company shall be a continuation of the company
- 13 <u>formed in Will County under "An Act to authorize the</u>
- 14 <u>formation of companies for the detection and apprehension of</u>
- horse thieves and other felons", filed July 7, 1885, as
- 16 amended. Any action taken by that company in accordance with
- 17 <u>that Act as that Act existed before its repeal by Public Act</u>
- 18 <u>76-754 is validated. The company shall have power to call to</u>
- 19 <u>its aid the peace officers of Will County in accordance with</u>
- 20 <u>law in the pursuit and apprehension of criminals and the</u>
- 21 recovery of stolen property. The company may add to its
- number or expel members. At a regular meeting of the company,
- 23 <u>the company may elect from its membership no more than 20</u>
- 24 members to be recommended to the Will County Sheriff for
- 25 <u>appointment as deputy sheriffs</u>. These 20 members so selected
- 26 <u>shall be eliqible upon a finding that they have previously or</u>

- officers. In case of a vacancy or vacancies on account of
