- 4 (b) The Department shall make grants and pay for the
- 5 staffing, administration, and related support from the
- 6 International Tourism Fund, a special fund created in the
- 7 State Treasury. Of the amounts deposited into the Fund in
- 8 fiscal year 2000 after January 1, 2000, 55% shall be used for
- 9 grants to convention and tourism bureaus in Chicago (other
- than the City of Chicago's Office of Tourism) and 45% shall
- 11 be used for development of international tourism in areas
- 12 outside of Chicago. Of the amounts deposited into the Fund
- in fiscal year 2001 and thereafter, 27.5% shall be used for
- 14 grants to the City of Chicago's Office of Tourism, 27.5%
