Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
changing Section 143.28 as follows:

б (215 ILCS 5/143.28) (from Ch. 73, par. 755.28) 7 Sec. 143.28. The rates and premium charges for all policies of automobile insurance, as described in sub-section 8 (a) of Section 143.13 of this Code, shall include appropriate 9 reductions for insured automobiles which are equipped with 10 anti-theft mechanisms or devices approved by the Director. 11 To implement the provisions of this Section, the Director 12 13 shall promulgate rules and regulations. The--rules--and regulations--promulgated--hereunder--shall-include-procedures 14 for-certification-to-insurers-that-anti-theft-mechanisms--and 15 16 devices-have-been-installed-properly-in-insured-vehicles.
