- 1 AN ACT in relation to vehicles.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 11-212 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-212 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 11-212. Roadside safety stops without probable</u>
- 8 <u>cause prohibited.</u>
- 9 (a) A police officer may not conduct a roadside safety
- 10 <u>check of a motor vehicle without probable cause that the</u>
- 11 <u>driver of the vehicle has violated a provision of this Code</u>
- 12 <u>or a similar provision of a local ordinance. Any evidence</u>
- obtained against the driver who was stopped in violation of
- 14 this Section is inadmissible in any prosecution of a
- violation of this Code or of a similar violation of a local
- 16 <u>ordinance</u>.
- 17 (b) In this Section, "roadside safety check" means the
- 18 stopping of each motor vehicle by a police officer at a
- 19 particular location without probable cause for the purpose of
- 20 <u>determining whether the driver of the vehicle has committed a</u>
- 21 <u>violation of this Code or a similar provision of a local</u>
- 22 <u>ordinance.</u>
