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AN ACT relating to higher education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Board of Higher Education Act is amended
by changing Section 7 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 205/7) (from Ch. 144, par. 187)

Sec. 7. The Board of Trustees of the University of 7 8 Illinois, the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University, the Board of Trustees of 9 Chicago State the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois 10 University, University, the Board of Trustees of Governors 11 State Board of Trustees of Illinois State 12 University, the 13 University, the Board of Trustees of Northeastern Illinois University, the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois 14 the Board of Trustees of Western Illinois 15 University, 16 University, the Illinois Community College Board and the campuses under their governance or supervision shall not 17 18 hereafter undertake the establishment of any new unit of instruction, research or public service without the approval 19 20 of the Board. The term "new unit of instruction, research or public service" includes the establishment of a college, 21 22 school, division, institute, department or other unit in any instruction, research or public service not 23 field of theretofore included in the program of the 24 institution, and 25 includes the establishment of any new branch or campus. The term does not include reasonable and moderate extensions of 26 27 existing curricula, research, or public service programs which have a direct relationship to existing programs; and 28 29 the Board may, under its rule making power, define the character of such reasonable and moderate extensions. 30

31 Such governing boards shall submit to the Board all

proposals for a new unit of instruction, research, or public service. The Board may approve or disapprove the proposal in whole or in part, or approve modifications thereof, or grant conditional approval with final approval or disapproval required within 3 years whenever in its judgment such action is consistent with the objectives of an existing or proposed master plan of higher education.

8 The Board of Higher Education is authorized to review 9 periodically all existing programs of instruction, research 10 and public service at the state universities and colleges and 11 to advise the appropriate board of control if the 12 contribution of each program is not educationally and 13 economically justified.
