- 4 Section 5. The Child Care Act of 1969 is amended by

- 7 <u>Sec. 4.5. Children with disabilities; training.</u>
- 8 (a) An operator of a licensed child care facility must
- 9 <u>successfully complete a basic training course in providing</u>
- 10 <u>care to children with disabilities</u>. Evidence satisfactory to
- 11 <u>the Department demonstrating successful completion of a basic</u>
- 12 training course in providing care to children with
- disabilities must be presented to the Department before
- 14 applying for a license or renewal of a license in 2002 and
- 15 <u>thereafter</u>. Once an operator has presented satisfactory
- 16 <u>evidence of completion of the basic training course to the</u>
