AN ACT in regard to highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Toll Highway Act is amended by changing
Section 8 as follows:

Sec. 8. The Authority shall have the power:

8 (a) To acquire, own, use, hire, lease, operate and 9 dispose of personal property, real property, any interest 10 therein, including rights-of-way, franchises and easements.

(b) To enter into all contracts and agreements necessary or incidental to the performance of its powers under this Act. All employment contracts let under this Act shall be in conformity with the applicable provisions of <u>the Prevailing</u> <u>Wage Act</u> "An-Act-regulating-wages-of-laborers,-mechanics-and other-workers-employed-under--contracts--for--public--works," approved-June-26,-1941,-as-amended.

(c) To employ and discharge, without regard to the 18 requirements of any civil service or personnel act, such 19 20 administrative, engineering, traffic, architectural, construction, and financial experts, and inspectors, and such 21 22 other employees, as are necessary in the Authority's judgment to carry out the purposes of this Act; and to establish and 23 administer standards of classification of all of such persons 24 with respect to their compensation, duties, performance, and 25 26 tenure; and to enter into contracts of employment with such 27 persons for such periods and on such terms as the Authority deems desirable. 28

(d) To appoint by and with the consent of the Attorney
General, assistant attorneys for such Authority, which said
assistant attorneys shall be under the control, direction and

supervision of the Attorney General and shall serve at his
 pleasure.

3 (e) To retain special counsel, subject to the approval 4 of the Attorney General, as needed from time to time, and fix 5 their compensation, provided however, such special counsel 6 shall be subject to the control, direction and supervision of 7 the Attorney General and shall serve at his pleasure.

8 (f) To acquire, construct, relocate, operate, regulate 9 and maintain a system of toll highways through and within the State of Illinois. However, the Authority does not have the 10 11 power to acquire, operate, regulate or maintain any system of toll highways or toll bridges or portions of them (including 12 but not limited to any system organized pursuant to Division 13 108 of Article 11 of the Illinois Municipal Code) in 14 the event either of the following conditions exists at the time 15 16 the proposed acquisition, operation, regulation or maintenance of such system is to become effective: 17

18 (1) the principal or interest on bonds or other 19 instruments evidencing indebtedness of the system are in 20 default; or

(2) the principal or interest on bonds or other instruments evidencing indebtedness of the system have been in default at any time during the 5 year period prior to the proposed acquisition.

To facilitate such construction, operation and maintenance and subject to the approval of the Division of Highways of the Department of Transportation, the Authority shall have the full use and advantage of the engineering staff and facilities of the Department.
