- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons
- 5 Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act is
- 6 amended by adding Section 9.2 as follows:
- 7 (320 ILCS 25/9.2 new)
- 8 <u>Sec. 9.2. Pharmaceutical Assistance Program Review</u>
- 9 <u>Committee</u>. The <u>Pharmaceutical Assistance Program Review</u>
- 10 <u>Committee is created. The committee shall consist of 17</u>
- 11 <u>members as follows:</u>
- 12 (1) 2 members of the General Assembly appointed by
- 13 <u>the President of the Senate, 2 members of the General</u>
- 14 Assembly appointed by the minority leader of the Senate,
- 15 <u>2 members of the General Assembly appointed by the</u>
- Speaker of the House of Representatives and 2 members of
- the General Assembly appointed by the minority leader of
- the House of Representatives;
- 19 <u>(2) the Director of Aging or his or her designee;</u>
- 20 (3) the Director of Revenue or his or her designee;
- 21 (4) the Director of Public Aid or his or her
- 22 designee;
- 23 (5) the Secretary of Human Services or his or her
- 24 <u>designee;</u>
- 25 <u>(6) a representative of AARP;</u>
- 26 <u>(7) a representative of the Pharmaceutical Research</u>
- 27 <u>and Manufacturers of America;</u>
- 28 <u>(8) a representative of the Illinois Pharmacists</u>
- 29 <u>Association;</u>
- 30 (9) the Director of Public Health or his or her
- 31 <u>designee</u>; and

- 1 (10) a representative of the Illinois State Medical
- 2 Society.
- 3 The President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of
- 4 Representatives shall each designate one member to serve as
- 5 <u>co-chairs. The Committee shall meet at the call of the</u>
- 6 <u>co-chairs. Members shall serve without compensation but may</u>
- 7 <u>be reimbursed for necessary expenses. The Committee may</u>
- 8 <u>conduct public hearings to gather testimony from interested</u>
- 9 parties regarding the necessity for pharmaceutical assistance
- 10 for Illinois seniors including changes to the pharmaceutical
- 11 <u>assistance program. The Committee shall report to the General</u>
