AN ACT in relation to vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing Section 11-1404 as follows: 5

б (625 ILCS 5/11-1404) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1404)

Sec. 11-1404. Special equipment for persons riding 7 8 motorcycles, motor driven cycles, or motorized pedalcycles.

9 (a) The operator and every passenger of a motorcycle, motor driven cycle, or motorized pedalcycle must wear a 10 helmet and must and-every-passenger-thereon-shall be 11 12 protected by glasses, goggles, or a transparent shield.

13 (b) For the purposes of this Section, glasses, goggles, and transparent shields are defined as follows: 14

15 "Glasses" means ordinary eye pieces such as spectacles or 16 sunglasses worn before the eye, made of shatter-resistant material. Shatter-resistant material, as used in this 17 Section, means material so manufactured, fabricated, or 18 created that it substantially prevents shattering or flying 19 20 when struck or broken.

"Goggles" means a device worn before the eyes, 21 the 22 predominant function of which is protecting the eyes without obstructing peripheral vision. 23 Goggles shall provide protection from the front and sides, and may or may not form 24 25 a complete seal with the face.

"Transparent shield" means a windshield attached to the 26 27 front of a motorcycle that extends above the eyes when an operator is seated in the normal, upright riding position, 28 made of shatter-resistant material, or a shatter-resistant 29 protective face shield that covers the wearer's eyes and face 30 31 at least to a point approximately to the tip of the nose.

- (c) Contact lenses are not acceptable eye protection
 devices.
