The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the purpose of funding expenses associated with processing backlogged files pursuant to the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Program.

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Section 2a. The sum of \$553,400, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs associated with the development and implementation of a Global Positioning System (GPS) program for field staff access and auditing data collection and reporting on underground storage tank systems in Illinois.

Section 3. The sum of \$276,500, or so much thereof as
may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground
Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for

The amount of \$40,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, and as remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2001, from an appropriation heretofore 3 4 made for such purpose in Article 46, Section 22 of Public Act 91-706, as amended, is reappropriated from the Fund for 5 6 Illinois' Future to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for 7 a grant to the City of Granite City for the purpose of purchasing fire equipment. 8

Section 11. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, and as remains unexpended at the close 18 19 of business on June 30, 2001, from appropriations heretofore made for such purpose in Article 46, Section 27 of Public Act 20 21 as amended, is reappropriated from the Fund for Illinois' Future to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for 22 23 units of local government for public safety infrastructure improvements including but not limited to facilities, 24 25 vehicles and equipment.
