AN ACT concerning immunizations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Department of Public Health Act is 5 amended by changing Section 8.4 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 2305/8.4)

Sec. 8.4. Immunization Advisory Committee. The Director 7 8 of Public Health shall appoint an Immunization Advisory Committee to advise the Director on immunization issues. The 9 Director shall take into consideration any comments or 10 recommendations made by the Advisory Committee. 11 The 12 Immunization Advisory Committee shall be composed of the 13 following members with knowledge of immunization issues: а pediatrician, a physician licensed to practice medicine in 14 15 all its branches, a family physician, an infectious disease 16 specialist from a university based center, 2 representatives of a local health department, a registered nurse, a school 17 18 nurse, a public health provider, a public health officer or administrator, a representative of a children's hospital, 19 2 20 representatives of immunization advocacy organizations, a representative from the State Board of Education, <u>a person</u> 21 22 with expertise in bioterrorism issues, and any other individuals or organization representatives designated by the 23 Director. The Director shall designate one of the Advisory 24 25 Committee members to serve as the Chairperson of the Advisory 26 Committee.
