- 4 Section 5. The Medicaid Revenue Act is amended by adding

- (7) The name and address of each provider of pharmacy or other authorized services under Medicaid with respect to whom the expenditures for authorized services or prescriptions under Medicaid for more than 10% of the provider's Medicaid patients during that quarter exceeded 25% of the average cost.
- (8) The reasons that expenditures for authorized services or prescriptions or the number of prescriptions filled or refilled under Medicaid during that quarter exceeded the appropriate average.
