- 9 <u>Sec. 21.4-1. Unlawful interference with access to health</u>
- 10 <u>care</u>. It is unlawful for a person to intentionally prevent
- or attempt to prevent an individual from entering or exiting
- 12 <u>a health care facility by physically detaining the individual</u>
- or physically obstructing, hindering, or impeding the
- 14 <u>individual's passage.</u>
- 15 (720 ILCS 5/21.4-2 new)
- Sec. 21.4-2. Definition. As used in this Article,
- 17 <u>"health care facility" means a private or public facility</u>
- 18 that provides health care services directly to any person,
- 19 <u>including but not limited to, a hospital, clinic, licensed</u>
- 20 <u>health practitioner's office, health maintenance</u>
- 21 <u>organization</u>, or <u>diagnostic</u> or <u>treatment</u> center.

- Sec. 21.4-3. Penalty. Unlawful interference with access
- 24 <u>to health care is a Class A misdemeanor.</u>

- 1 (1) Lawful conduct protected by the First Amendment to
