- 7 Sec. 31-1. Resisting or obstructing a peace officer or
- 8 correctional institution employee.
- 9 (a) A person who knowingly resists or obstructs the
- 10 performance by one known to the person to be a peace officer
- 11 or correctional institution employee of any authorized act
- 12 within his or her official capacity commits a Class A
- 13 misdemeanor.
- 14 (b) For purposes of this Section, "correctional
- institution employee" means any person employed to supervise
- 16 and control inmates incarcerated in a penitentiary, State
- farm, reformatory, prison, jail, house of correction, police
- detention area, half-way house, or other institution or place
- 19 for the incarceration or custody of persons under sentence
- 20 for offenses or awaiting trial or sentence for offenses,
