- 10 "Benchmarking" means health benefits coverage as defined
- in Section 2103 of the <u>Federal</u> Social Security Act.
- "Child" means a person under the age of 19.
- "Department" means the Department of Public Aid.
- 14 "Medical assistance" means health care benefits provided
- under Article V of the Illinois Public Aid Code.
- "Medical visit" means a hospital, dental, physician,
- 17 optical, or other health care visit where services are
- 18 provided pursuant to this Act.
- 19 "Program" means the Children's Health Insurance Program,
- 20 which includes subsidizing the cost of privately sponsored
- 21 health insurance and purchasing or providing health care
- 22 benefits for eligible children.
- 23 "Resident" means a person who meets the residency
- 24 requirements as defined in Section 5-3 of the Illinois Public
- 25 Aid Code.
