1 AN ACT in relation to housing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Housing Development Act is 5 amended by changing Section 7 and adding Section 7.30 as 6 follows:

8 Sec. 7. The Authority may exercise the powers set forth

12 Sec. 7.30. Financial assistance for new teachers. The 13 Authority may develop and implement a program of financial 14 assistance, subject to appropriation, for new teachers purchasing a first home. The program shall consist of 15 financial assistance to recently hired teachers to obtain 16 17 30-year mortgages, at interest rates no greater than those 18 for mortgages under the Authority's other programs for first-time home buyers, for the purchase of primary 19 residences for the first time. Assistance shall be available 20 21 only to teachers employed by school districts defined by the State Board of Education as financially needy or experiencing 22 a shortage of teachers. The program shall be limited to 23 persons employed at the time of application as elementary or 24 secondary public school teachers who have been employed in 25 any teaching positions cumulatively for no more than 2 years 26 at the time of application and who commit to continue 27 teaching in the public schools of the school district for at 28 least 3 years after their closing date. An eligible 29 residence must be located in Illinois and must be the 30
