15 Air Force, serving during the Korean War; he was president of
16 the Cass County Abstract Company and was a member of the
17 Morgan County Bar Association, the Jacksonville Elks Club,
18 American Legion Post 279, and VFW Post 1379; and

19 WHEREAS, The passing of Bill G. Colburn will be deeply
20 felt by all who knew and loved him, especially his son,
21 Charles (wife, Lynn) Colburn; his daughter, Linda (husband,
22 Art Tustin) Colburn; his two grandchildren; and his partner,
