To the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board,

On behalf of the Moline Police Department for the City of Moline I would like to submit the mandated body worn camera/in-car cameras report pursuant to 50 ILCS 706/10-25 and 50 ILCS 707/15, 20 for the 2019 calendar year.

- The Moline Police Department has 84 body worn cameras in use and 32 in-car cameras in use.
- The Moline Police Department currently has 81 cameras used by Moline Police Officers.
- The technical issues related to the body worn cameras cameras have been an inability to upload videos, inability to connect to the internet, an inability to connect to the in-car camera and inability for the battery inside the camera to recharge. Technical issues related to in-car cameras have been an inability to connect to the internet and upload videos. The issues were remedied by replacing the camera with a functioning camera. It was also remedied by working with Axon to receive firmware updates.
- The Moline Police Department has a policy in place as to how we review videos created by the use of the body worn cameras and in-car cameras. Supervisors are required to review one recorded video for each Moline Police Officer assigned to their shift, to ensure the body worn camera is being utilized. Once the recorded video has been reviewed the supervisor documents the review in the notes section provided by evidence.com
- Please see attached document for each instance the body worn camera was used in a prosecution. The attachment will provide the date, time, location, offense, and charging date.
