



Remote Legislative Hearing Process

Pursuant to Senate Rule 3-1(f), the President, in consultation with the Minority Leader, may establish a process by which Senators and members of the public may participate remotely in hearings for standing committees, special committees, subcommittees or special subcommittees, and service committees.

Under this process, utilizing Zoom video teleconferencing technology, Committee members and scheduled witnesses will be able to testify remotely on the subject matter scheduled for a remote testimony meeting by the committee chairperson.

The committee hearing will be broadcast on the General Assembly's website **here**: <https://www.ilga.gov/SenateAudVid.asp>. The committee chair will call the meeting to order. The committee chair will call upon members and witnesses individually to testify. Members and those testifying should remain muted until called upon.
