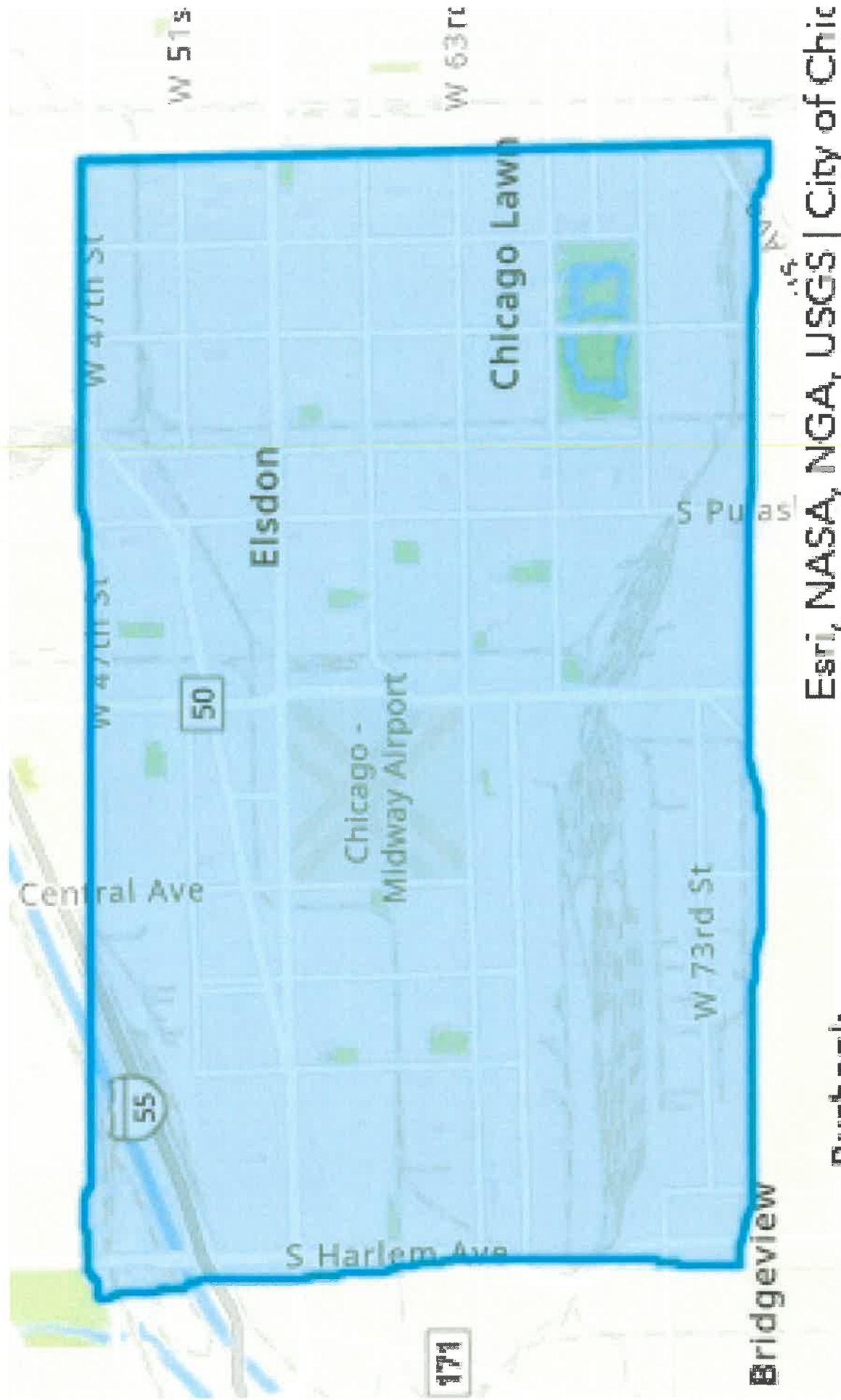


Andrew Martinek Short Description

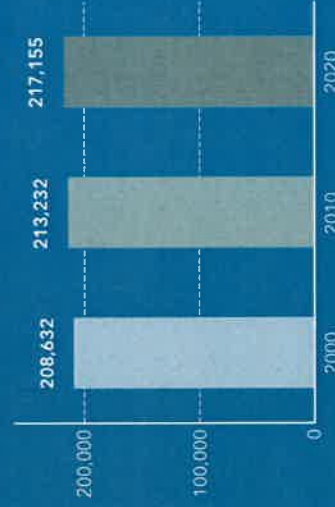

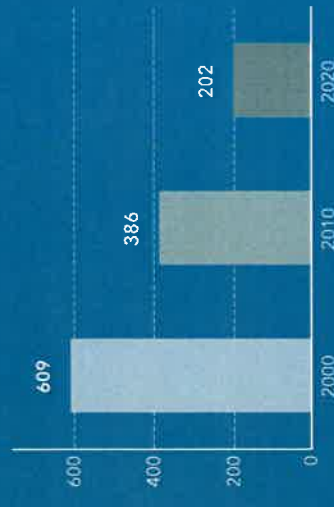

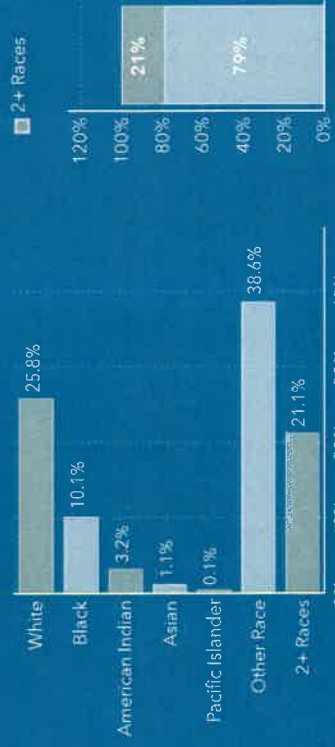
HOUSEHOLD POPULATION



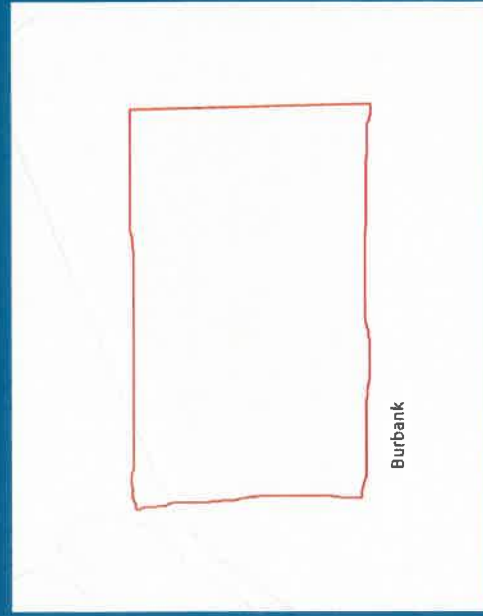

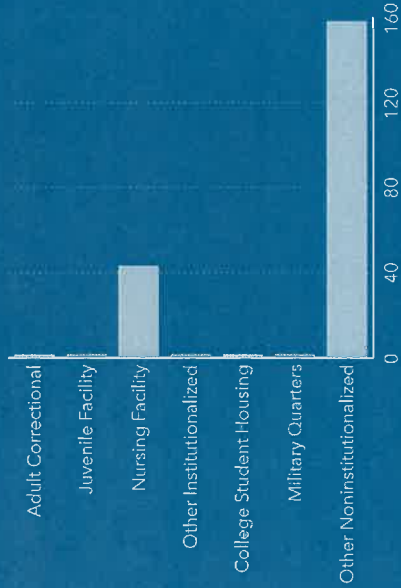
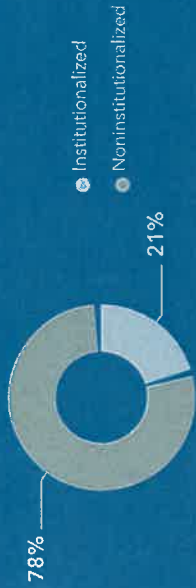
