And what he did for those people who were extremely scared is -- is something that reminds me of what I saw in the military, in Iraq - bravery, people who go above and beyond the call of duty and that are willing to sacrifice their own life for others. There's no higher calling on this -- on this planet, on Earth, than to prevent people from getting hurt. And Senator Elgie Sims is that person. I just want to give him a round of applause. On behalf of the south suburbs, thank you. Thank you for what you did.
