That's really technical, isn't it...that's really technical.

SENATOR ROCK:

Thank you, Mr. President, Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate. Amendment No. 1 was successfully offered in committee. It effectively deleted everything after the enacting clause and instate...installs in its place the "Prairie Two Thousand Fund." What this does is provide the financing mechanism for the Prairie State Two Thousand program in terms of affording a tax deduction to employers who voluntarily participate. The money which will be engendered will be provided to individuals in terms of vouchers for the purpose of

training and retraining. The amendment is a rather lengthy one, I would seek its adoption with the full and complete understanding that I will hold the bill once the amendment is printed and those who wish to offer further amendments will certainly be afforded that opportunity. I would like the amendment adopted and ask that the bill be moved to the Order of 3rd Reading.

Thank you, Mr. President. At this time I would like to move to Table Committee Amendment No. 1 because it is...has some technical defects.

SENATOR ROCK:

I wonder if the...question of the sponsor, Mr. President.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

He indicates he'll yield.

SENATOR ROCK:

Might I ask you, Senator, to repeat your explanation of this and...and the reason that we are doing this.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator DeAngelis.

SENATOR DeANGELIS:

Okay. What the amendment does is...makes the county clerk or the State Board of Elections, as the case may be, provide each candidate for nomination under this Article with copies of petitions for nomination and a set of instructions, with respect thereto. You want to know why? Alright. We had an election in our area, in Cook County, and, I think other single county jurisdictions, the petitions are prepared by a private party. The private party printed a petition that was defective, and when the candidates filled out those petitions, they were all thrown off the ballot by a guy who was real sharp, because the petition itself was defective...the printing of the petition.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Rock.

SENATOR ROCK:

Well, does this apply to each and every election, park board, library board, township, county, State, Federal, you-name-it? Does this apply to everything?

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator DeAngelis.

SENATOR DeANGELIS:

I think it does...it...it's in that paragraph that...in the Consolidated Election Code, and I would imagine it would...probably would.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Rock.

SENATOR ROCK:

No, I...I just think, frankly...did the...did the clerks and the State Board testify as to the cost of this? What...what kind of duty are we imposing on them? You give the candidate the petition, you give them the instruction booklet, you give him his own crayon and you send them out. It seems to me there ought to be some responsibility on the part of the candidate for public office. At the very least, he ought to be in a position to...to know how to circulate a nominating petition, a valid nominating petition. I...I just...what...what are we doing to ourselves?

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator DeAngelis.

SENATOR DeANGELIS:

I think on multi...Senator Rock, I'm not sure on this, but I think on multi-county elections they do, in fact, furnish the petitions, but in single county elections, I don't think they do, so in some instances they are doing it. I think a lot of the people that...that take these petitions, ...who might, in fact, be running for the first time, don't know whether they're right or not. And, yet, they have to

purchase them from a private party.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Grotberg.

SENATOR GROTBORG:

Yes, a question of the sponsor. Would you yield?

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

He indicates he'll yield.

SENATOR GROTBORG:

Senator DeAngelis, I think most legislators, that I know and others, take the format and go out and get ten lines to a page or something, or fifteen, so you could read it and see what's going on, and it's easier for someone to get you a page. This mandates, I gather, that...that would all be done and the...we'd only use the company line. Is that what we're getting at?

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator DeAngelis.

SENATOR DeANGELIS:

I don't think it's necessary to give them five hundred copies of it, but I think the...the proper petition, one should be given to that person.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Grotberg.

SENATOR GROTBORG:

It doesn't say that...I sneaked over to your desk and read it, but I like the idea of giving everybody one proper format and let him go to his printer, if necessary, or he can get more of those free of charge, but it seems to me the amendment doesn't quite get at where I'm coming from.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there any further discussion? Senator Nedza.

SENATOR NEDZA:

Yes, thank you, Mr. President, a question of the sponsor.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

He indicates he'll yield.

SENATOR NEDZA:

Senator DeAngelis, you know...everybody in this Body has had the occasion of running for office. Is it not that...is it...is it not incumbent upon that person or persons who are running for a specific office to ascertain the authenticity of the petition that they're having as...as they would have to file required forms, or whatever else you would have to...do? Would not that incumbency be upon them as opposed to this form of legislation?

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator DeAngelis.

SENATOR DeANGELIS:

Well, I...I think we're getting at the debating the bill and so forth, but from what I understand, you are required to purchase this from a private party. Now, unless somebody is expert on the Election Law, which a lot of people aren't, I'm not so sure that...and you're directed to certain parties who to buy it from. I mean in references to certain companies that sell these things, but, I'm not so sure that they would be able to determine the authenticity of them. I mean, I couldn't tell you if a petition is legal or not.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator...Nedza.

SENATOR NEDZA:

Well, wouldn't you...I know most certainly that I do, as I go to my county clerk and I have him check the petitions as I think that's available to everybody in the entire State.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there further discussion? If not, Senator DeAngelis moves the adoption of...Senator Rock.

SENATOR ROCK:

For a second time and I apologize for that, but with no idea of the cost, I would presume that this too would be cov-

ered, since we're imposing a duty on the county clerk, at least in the County of Cook, and when a candidate for township, or school board, or library board, or mosquito abatement or whatever else we run for up there walks in, he's entitled to copies of valid petitions and instructions. Now, that's a mandate and, thus, our county would be entitled to some reimbursement from the State under the State Mandates Act, I presume, or do I presume incorrectly?

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator DeAngelis.

SENATOR DeANGELIS:

I don't know, Senator Rock.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

(Machine cutoff)...Macdonald.

SENATOR MACDONALD:

Yes, as Minority Spokesman on Elections, as I understood the committee amendment, it merely requires that the county clerk would give a sample of the ballot. It was not my understanding, Senator DeAngelis, that they would supply the ballots, it would be just the proper form. You could take it then to your own printers. That was my understanding, as you presented the bill and that is, the analysis in our book of what the bill does. I would think that a sample...then you take it to your printer, but certainly the county clerk would not be expected to sustain the expense for all of the petitions for all of the candidates.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator DeAngelis.

SENATOR DeANGELIS:

Yeah, this is actually on the nominating petitions; it's not on the ballots, and that's fine with me. Do you want me to pull it out of the record and amend it to do so?

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

President Rock.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Well, I would certainly like to see you pulled it out of the record because I think there's some confusion, now; because if that's the understanding, that is not what the amendment says, I can assure you.

Senator DeAngelis. Senator DeAngelis seeks leave to pull it out of the record. Take it out of the record. Senate Bill 1097, Senator Rigney. Senate Bill 1098, Senator Rock. Read the bill, Mr. Secretary.

And, there was some concern raised...justifiable concern raised, so Amendment No. 1 strikes that provision and leaves the law as it currently is, and I know of no objection and I would move the adoption of
